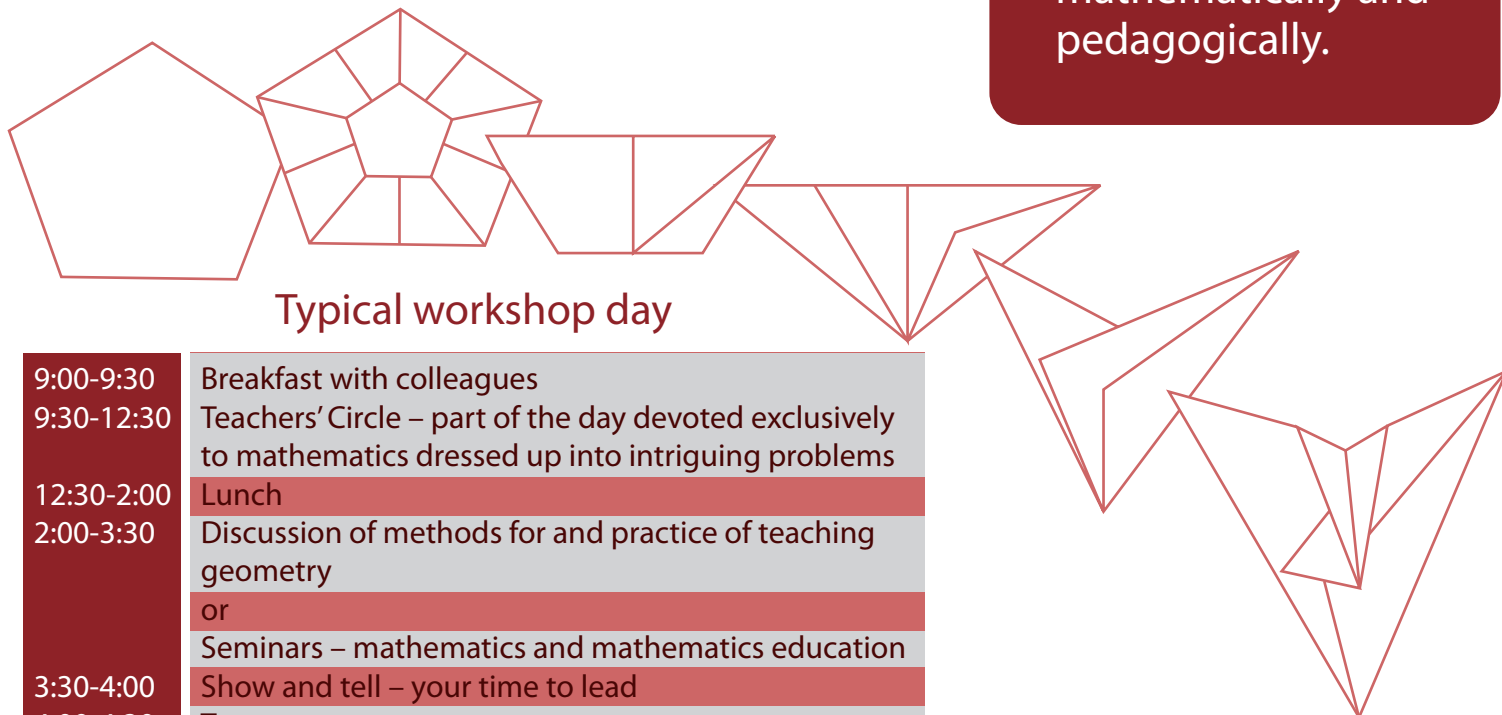


Geometry workshop for teachers

Typical workshop day

9:00-9:30	Breakfast with colleagues
9:30-12:30	Teachers' Circle – part of the day devoted exclusively to mathematics dressed up into intriguing problems
12:30-2:00	Lunch
2:00-3:30	Discussion of methods for and practice of teaching geometry or Seminars – mathematics and mathematics education
3:30-4:00	Show and tell – your time to lead
4:00-4:30	Tea
4:30-6:00	Lesson plan study - time to translate new knowledge into lessons that you can use and share with your colleagues
Evenings	Free, and hopefully spent in the good company of your colleagues

Participants can stay at the University of Utah dorm housing. Funding is available for travel costs and per diem. Teachers who do not live in Salt Lake Valley will be given preference in terms of support, but everybody is welcome to apply and attend. Applications will be reviewed starting in April. Review will continue until early July or until all the openings are filled.
