	Question: Comments on course effectiveness
	It was very confusing to have 3 websites to keep track of during the course. It was also difficult to follow formats for different assignments. Having the exams, quizzes, and homework all require different formats (i.e. use spaces, don't use spaces, decimals v fractions) made it difficult to follow and points were missed not because of incorrect answers, but because of format problems.
	The lecture videos did not talk about certain concepts in the hometown. They were very disjointed. The tests did not reflect the homework or the readings. The readings didn't seem to help with the homework or quizzes either.
	Since we needed to pay for our own access to WebAssign, why a separate uOnline fee? It should be a discount, since you don't need a maintain a classroom. WebAssign was mediocre at best. Slow loading. Text was difficult to read on screen (rather than a sharp vector image, it appeared as a fuzzy, low-resolution raster). Canvas quizzes were awful. I have no idea why quizzes were done in Canvas (bad math formatting), when WebAssign is made for math. It sure would have been nice to use simple calculators during tests, just for speed and double-checking arithmetic errors.
	I HATED the lectures. Being taught by several different instructors was difficult to adjust to by itself, but then 2 of the instructors left out a great deal. One didn't teach on about half of the homework, even after I looked at supplementary materials, and the other skipped a large amount of steps, which makes things much harder for someone struggling with the concept. It also infuriated me that I could watch and take notes on all the lectures, read the books, work through the supplementary material and when I hit my homework (finally) I would STILL have to look up Khan Academy videos just to get through it! Why even pay tuition at that point?!?! I could have just played through on Khan Academy.
